Dear Parents / Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you and your family well and enjoying summer. As summer rolls on, I'm sure that from time to time you will find yourself wondering what the new school year might look like for your student.

At this time, although we are unable to predict the structure and organization of learning in September, we are preparing to welcome new students and welcome back those who are returning to North Delta. We anticipate schools may transition in and out of different stages throughout the 2020-21 school year. This could include some combination of in-person and remote instruction.

In the meantime, the information below is intended to help you plan ahead.

School Tours

School tours for all Grade 8 and new students are tentatively scheduled to be held during the day on Wed, Aug 26 and Thurs, Aug 27. During the week of Aug 17-21, we hope to share an electronic form with you so you can register for school tours. Tours will be led by leadership students and conducted in physically distant, small groups. Our hope is that each student will be able to have one parent / guardian accompany them on the tour. Tours will include a welcome by the administration, followed by a walk through the key areas of the school and some classrooms. Families will also be provided an opportunity to sign off on important parent consent forms. This will be particularly helpful for families who are new to Delta School District and are not yet familiar with the use of Parent Connect.

Student Timetables

Tentatively, we plan to make Grade 9-12 student timetables available on Aug 25. At this time, we are unsure whether schedules will be available for viewing electronically or will require that students pick up a paper copy in person. Shortly after the release of student timetables, a process will be made available for students who notice errors in their timetables or have an incomplete schedule to request adjustments be made to their schedules.

The school and school district will continue to follow the guidelines of the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Health. We hope to provide more detailed plans for you in late August. Please continue to check our school website and monitor your email in late August for updated information. Have a great summer!
