



Creating a MYED Account & Course Selection

Students, please follow the instructions below to help students log in and complete the course selection process.

1. Go to MyED BC Website at: <https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspn/logon.do>
OR use the Quicklink on the NDSS website: nd.deltasd.bc.ca
2. Enter your Log-in and Password. If this is your first time logging in, use the login and password provided to you then follow steps 3 and 4. If you have logged in before, you will need to use the new password you have created – please skip to Step 5.

Password Requirements

- Minimum length is 8
- At least one number
- At least one capital and lowercase letter
- At least one symbol that isn't a letter or number
- Can't contain 'password', login name, first name, middle name, last name, date of birth, personal id, or only sequential letters or numbers

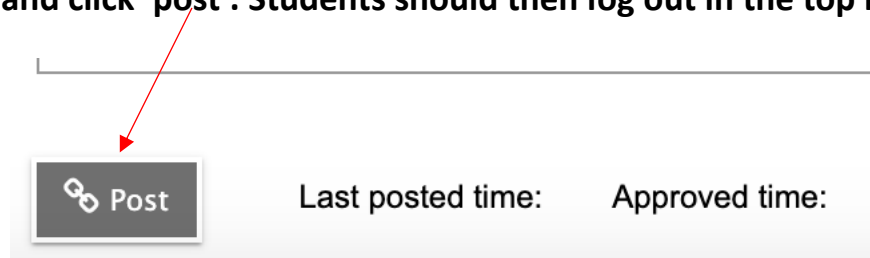

- 8. Students may leave a note about course selection for their counselor in the 'Counselor notes' section at the bottom of the page.** This is where students with special circumstances should indicate courses they need that may not be available to them (ie. I'm going into grade 11 but I need English 10, or I'm going into grade 11 but want Chem 12).
- 9. After selecting the required number of courses, scroll to the bottom of the page and click 'post'. Students should then log out in the top right corner.**
