

THE DHA PROGRAM



- Students pursue their passion in hockey by combining high level coaching, practice and games play with their formal educational program.
- Accepted DHA students will be enrolled at North Delta Secondary
- DHA students' educational program consists of courses at NDSS and at Planet Ice
- Students in Grade 8, 9 and a few in grade 10 take their NDSS courses in the morning, and have their rinkbased courses in the afternoon
- Most students in Grade 10, and all Grade 11 and 12 students have the braised courses in the morning and take their NDSS courses in the afternoon
- All instruction will be inperson, with a subject teacher providing direct instruction whether
 at NDSS or the rink.
