Students will be recognized for the following three types of awards at the Valedictory Ceremony:

1. Valedictory School-Based Awards

There are a number of scholarships, bursaries and other awards given by local businesses, organizations, families or special interest groups in our community to our school specifically. To receive one of the financial awards, a student must apply, meet the criteria and be selected by the school scholarship committee. Some of the awards listed may not be offered this year should the donor decide not to provide the funding.

2. District Authority Awards

This year, NDSS will be offering 26 separate awards worth \$1,250 just for ND Grads of 2024. These Ministry of Education awards are to acknowledge superior achievement within the areas of Fine Arts, Applied Skills, Second Languages, Physical Activity, Technical and Trades Training, Indigenous Languages and Culture or Community Service. Instructions for Redeeming Scholarships & Awards After Graduation

You may redeem your scholarship starting September 2024. Unless otherwise stated, you have three years to cash in your scholarship and award monies. Your awards will expire on September 30, 2027. To redeem your award, you must provide the following in person or by email to northdelta.sec@deltaschools.ca:

- Proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institution along with a receipt showing that you have paid
 either partial or full tuition fees. Please note that a receipt showing you've only paid the deposit is not
 sufficient proof.
- A formal "thank you" letter or card for the organization or individual that is providing you the scholarship or award. The school will mail your letter or card directly to the donor on your behalf.

Award recipients will be announced at the North Delta Secondary Valedictory Ceremony
