Reporting in Delta Schools for 2024/25

Dear Parents/Caregivers

As the school year is underway, we wanted to provide an update regarding how you can expect communication about your child’s learning this year. The BC Ministry of Education and Child Care’s Learning Update Order and K-12 Student Reporting Policy provides guidance to districts as to the frequency and type of communication required regarding your child’s learning. After listening to feedback from schools and the community last year, the District has expanded the type of communication teachers may use for informal updates in line with Ministry guidelines. Below please find information on how and when you can expect communication about your child’s learning at North Delta Secondary this year.

Secondary Semester Courses:

Each semester you can expect to receive the following updates:

- Informal Learning Update – this may take the form of parent-teacher interviews, emails or phone calls that provide a snapshot of your child’s learning in their current courses
- Written Learning Update – this report card is sent to you through MyEd BC and provides updates on all areas of learning
- Written Summary of Learning – this report card comes at the end of June through MyEd BC and provides you with updated learning progress to end the semester

For Students in Grades 10-12, along with the Summary of Learning, you will also be receiving a Graduation Status update indicating student progress in relation to graduation program requirements.

Secondary Linear Courses:

Over the course of the year you can expect to receive the following updates:

- 2 Informal Learning Updates – these may take the form of parent-teacher interviews, emails or phone calls that provide a snapshot of your child’s learning in their current courses
- 2 Written Learning Updates– these report cards are sent to you through MyEd BC and provide updates on all of your child’s current courses
- 1 Written Summary of Learning – this report card comes at the end of June through MyEd BC and provides you with updated learning progress to end the year
- For Students in Grades 10-12, along with the Summary of Learning, you will also be receiving a Graduation Status update indicating student progress in relation to graduation program requirements.

You may receive additional information as needed from your child’s teacher at any time during the school year. As well, should you have any questions about your child’s learning, please contact your child’s teacher.
