

Grade 11 Course Planning Sheet

Information about graduation requirements and all the courses offered at North Delta Secondary can be found in the [Course Selection](#) section on the school website. To meet graduation requirements, students must complete a minimum of 80 credits.

The following criteria must be met:

- at least 16 credits are Grade 12 level
- 52 credits are required courses
- 28 credits are electives which put include a Fine Arts or ADST course and 4 credits must be in indigenous focused course such as English First People 12 or BC First Peoples 12
- All courses are selected through MyED BC
- Students entering Grade 11 must take 8 courses and can take a 9th course outside of regular school hours
